- Assist with ongoing maintenance and development of the GIS and its applications.
- Carry out research related to historical records.

- Assist with the organization and maintenance of electronic and hard copy drawings and records related to Port infrastructure as required.
- Assist with site surveys, dredging volume calculations and measurements as required.
