In this challenging position, the individual will perform complex, technical and analytical work in support of the District's leading edge Geographic Information System (GIS). General responsibilities include: developing applications; creating, supporting and optimizing systems routines and; providing technical support where required. You will exercise considerable independent judgement and action within the framework of established guidelines.

The incumbent will: develop and design GIS applications for both the internet and the desktop; customize and support existing GIS applications; write and maintain system administration routines; implement quality control procedures; prepare and maintain documentation; perform analysis and produce reports; maintain systems and data where required and; establish and maintain effective working relationships with internal and external contacts.. You may also serve as the project leader for certain GIS projects.

The successful candidate must possess basic application development skills including HTML, SQL, and Javascript. Additionally, skills such as Adobe Flash and/or Adobe Flex are highly desirable. Previous GIS experience using ESRI's ArcGIS software is valuable but not essential.

The ideal candidate will have a GIS or computing science background; completed a GIS post-diploma program and possess 2-5 years of related experience. Candidates must have contributed to the development of a web-application that is currently accessible and is fully functional.
