The City of Nanaimo is seeking a Senior GIS Specialist. The incumbent will play a key role in developing, designing, implementing and maintaining the City Geographic Information System (GIS). Responsibilities include a wide range of technical duties related to the development of enterprise (City wide) GIS applications. This includes project planning, design and implementation of fully integrated databases related to the City's Corporate Land Base (cadastral), infrastructure and other spatial inventory features. The incumbent will also be responsible for directing the work of technical staff and GIS consultants and liaison with outside agencies to ensure that the municipal GIS work objectives are met.

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's Degree in Geographic Information Systems from a recognized University. Over six years of direct experience using GIS to manage infrastructure and land related data, preferably in a local government environment is required or an equivalent combination of qualifications, education and experience. A valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence is also required.
