## **GIS Mapping Technician (Temporary Full-Time)**

The City of Nanaimo is seeking a temporary full-time GIS Mapping Technician. The incumbent will support planning and operational initiatives through the entry, modification, maintenance, translation and conversion of spatial and attribute data, for a variety of City engineering activities and projects, as well as perform technical work related to spatial and attribute data in the creation of maps and generation of associated reports for GIS analysis. The Technician will integrate a wide range of geographical data using geographic information systems (GIS) applications (AutoCAD, Munsys, ArcInfo, ArcView) and relational database management systems to achieve results. In addition, the incumbent will oversee the engineering drawing repository. Independence of judgment and initiative in process improvement and solving technical and administrative problems is required.

Applicants will have completed Grade 12, supplemented by a Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized Technical Institute, plus an Advanced Diploma in GIS. A minimum of two years' experience in technical GIS and mapping is required. Applicants will have membership or be eligible for membership in the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of British Columbia (ASTTBC) as a Certified Technician or Applied Science Technologist. Possession of a valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence is also required.

This is a unionized position. \$31.95 per hour - after Probation (Jan 2013 Rate), based on a 35-hour work week. It is anticipated this vacancy will be up to six months in duration.
