- Modify data files received from others to meet PMV digital storage requirements and ensure that as-built drawings of all facilities and structures built on PMV property are received and recorded.
- Carry out research related to historical records.

- Assist with the organization and maintenance of electronic and hard copy drawings and records related to Port infrastructure and assets as required.
- Assist with site surveys, dredging volume calculations and measurements as required.
