We are recruiting a **Cost Sharing Technician** to work in Financial Arrangements and Cost Sharing, Treaties and Aboriginal Government, INAC.

As part of the Government of Canada, our focus is on the financial components of First Nations treaties in BC. The successful candidate would have an integral role in a unit whose primary role is to calculate, verify and negotiate how BC and Canada split the major costs of First Nations treaties (e.g. land, resources and cash).

More specifically, using ArcGIS, Excel, Oracle and other tools, the Technician's main duties would be to calculate and verify the value of land and resources for potential inclusion in treaties.

As you can imagine, the successful candidate would be in a job that is really crucial in our ongoing treaty negotiations!

To fulfill this function, the position involves working closely with representatives (e.g. negotiators) from our federal department as well as from provincial ministries (namely the Ministry of Aboriginal Relations and Reconciliation) and various consultants. The Technician also provides support and analysis to other various related projects.

The job is indeterminate, located in downtown Vancouver and has a starting salary of \$59,756. We plan to create a "pool" (a small inventory of successful, qualified candidates).
