Main Purpose & Function

As a member of IT Applications, this exempt position is required to be a project leader on technology projects through the preliminary investigation, analysis of requirements, business case and feasibility analysis, design, implementation, quality control, documentation, and post-implementation review phases. The position will conduct a range of projects. Examples include consolidation or replacement of in-house developed applications; development of new business applications; renovation of applications to be mobile device accessible; adoption of agile and lean software development methodologies; migrating and rearchitecting applications and integration to updated platforms; and piloting Application Productivity Platforms. This position is also extensively involved in coordinating support for both inhouse developed applications and purchased applications.

Specific Duties & Responsibilities

This position is required to develop and help enforce standards of industry-based best practices relating to the development environment including documentation, programming, data, testing, and procedures. This position is also required to work with Information Technology staff to maintain consistency and continuity with the City's overall technology standards and procedures. The position must remain current with developments in new technologies, including releases, enhancements/new functionality and best-of-breed business processes and practices. As well, the Systems Analyst II will deliver presentations to customers (users, departments) and other staff on business application processes, systems solutions and specific technologies.

Qualifications

The incumbent is expected to have a diploma or degree in Computer Science, Business Administration or a related discipline. Formal Project Management training is a definite asset. A minimum of five years of experience in developing and implementing business applications through a standard lifecycle approach, preferably in a municipal environment. Demonstrated knowledge of business applications and how they relate to and support business processes. Experience with business and systems analysis tools and techniques. Strong ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships and to work effectively with changing and competing priorities with frequent interruptions within a multiple task environment. Strong analytical and problem solving skills. Excellent oral, written and presentation/facilitation skills, with ability to communicate at all levels within the organization.



Two positions require a thorough knowledge of Web technologies, SQL query/reporting tools, software development methodologies, collaboration tools (i.e. SharePoint), and release and change management practices. Experience with UX Design, Agile/Lean methodologies, mobile application development and the MS Office platform and support of application integration is highly desirable.

The two positions will be TFT until March 31, 2017.

One position requires GIS knowledge and experience in Oracle Spatial database, Autodesk Infrastructure Map Server (AIMS), AutoCAD Map 3D and Industry Model, FME Desktop and Server, ESRI ArcGIS Server and related software. Experience with spatial data discovery and Open Data technologies, mobile GIS, geospatial analytics or spatially enabling Service-Oriented Architectures (SOA) is highly desirable. Formal training or certification such as GISP (GIS Information Systems Professional) designation or an Advanced Diploma in GIS is an asset.
