THE FOCUS

GIS software continues to increase in power while it becomes simpler to use, and includes options for intranet and internet solutions for infrastructure and asset management. Exchange of data between GIS, GPS and CAD systems, and sharing data with asset management software is becoming much simpler. These developments make web based GIS an excellent tool for managing municipal infrastructure data and improving asset management activities. The event will be divided into three tracks:

Track 1: Infrastructure and Asset Management Tools

The first track will provide information about GIS tools for infrastructure and asset management. The presentations will focus on tools and techniques for construction and development of an enterprise Infrastructure Management System. This track will also include case studies of applications available for assets management.

Track 2: Applications built on top of Web-based GIS solutions

The second track will focus on business applications built on top of web based applications for asset maintenance and management and will look at how they can be integrated with other information systems and processes.

Track 3: Web enabled Data sharing and Sensitive data

The third track will deal with role of intranet and internet in sharing data. This will also include a panel discussion on data sharing in a web based environment. In addition to the available data sharing standards the panelists will discuss issues about sharing sensitive data.
