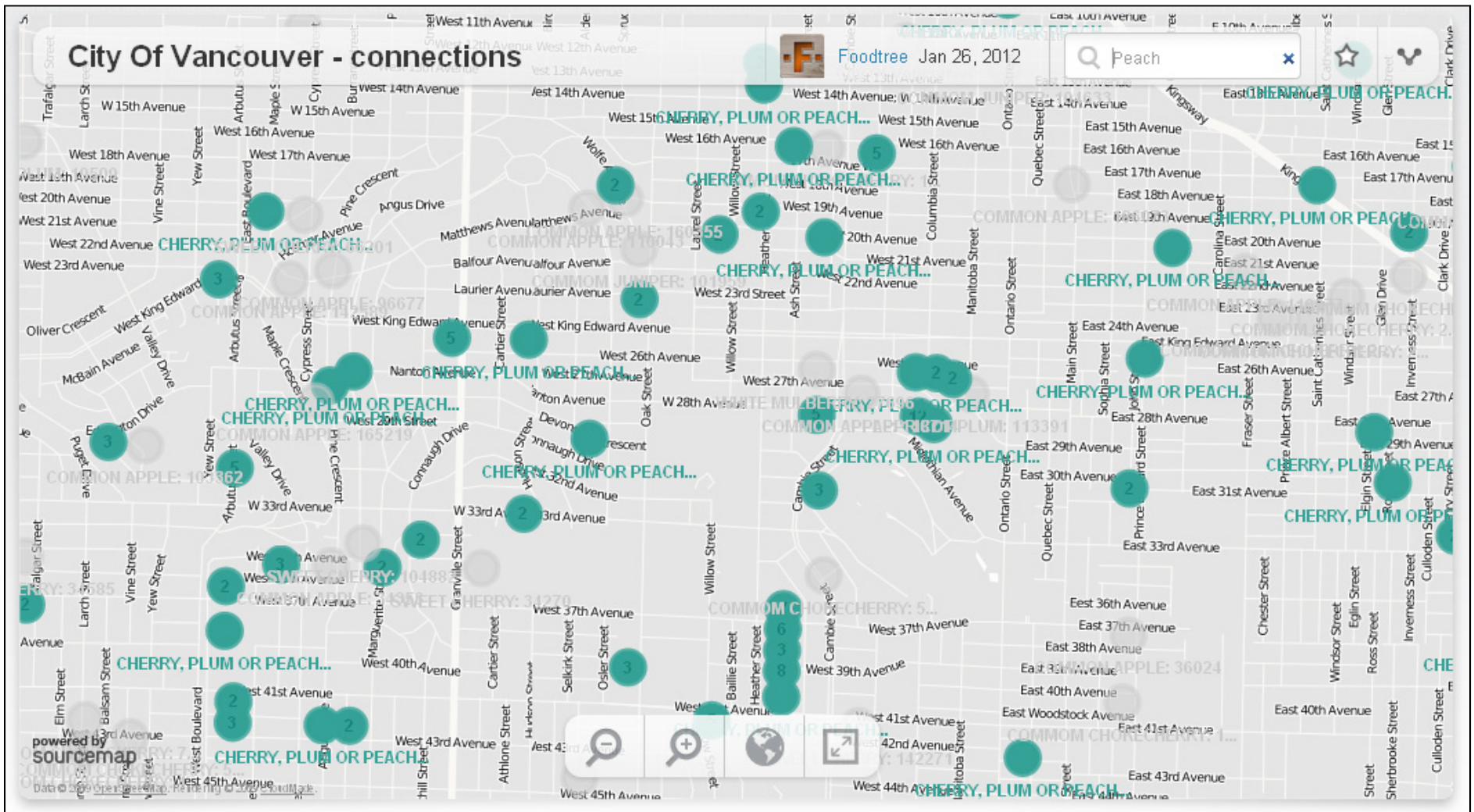

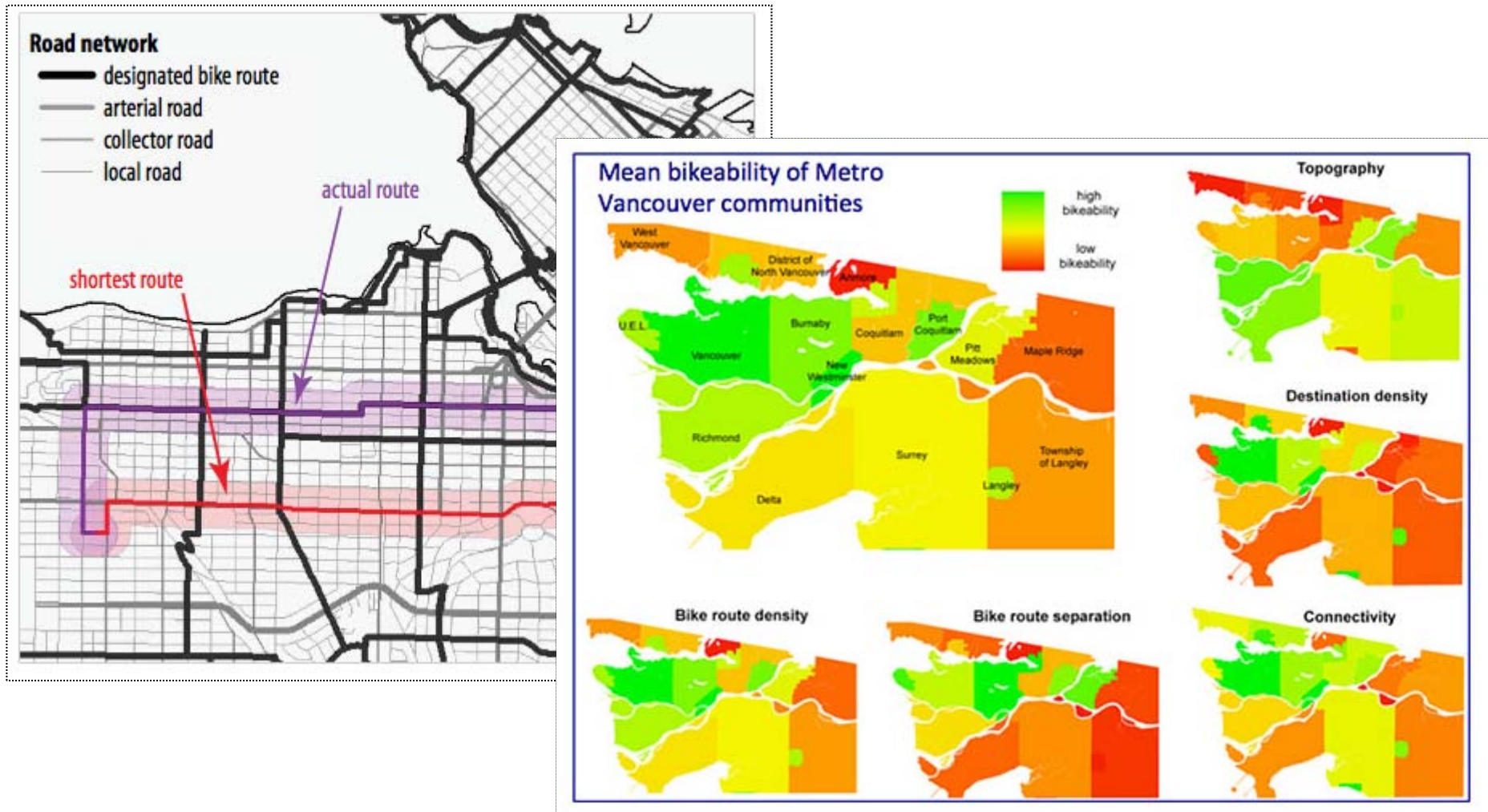

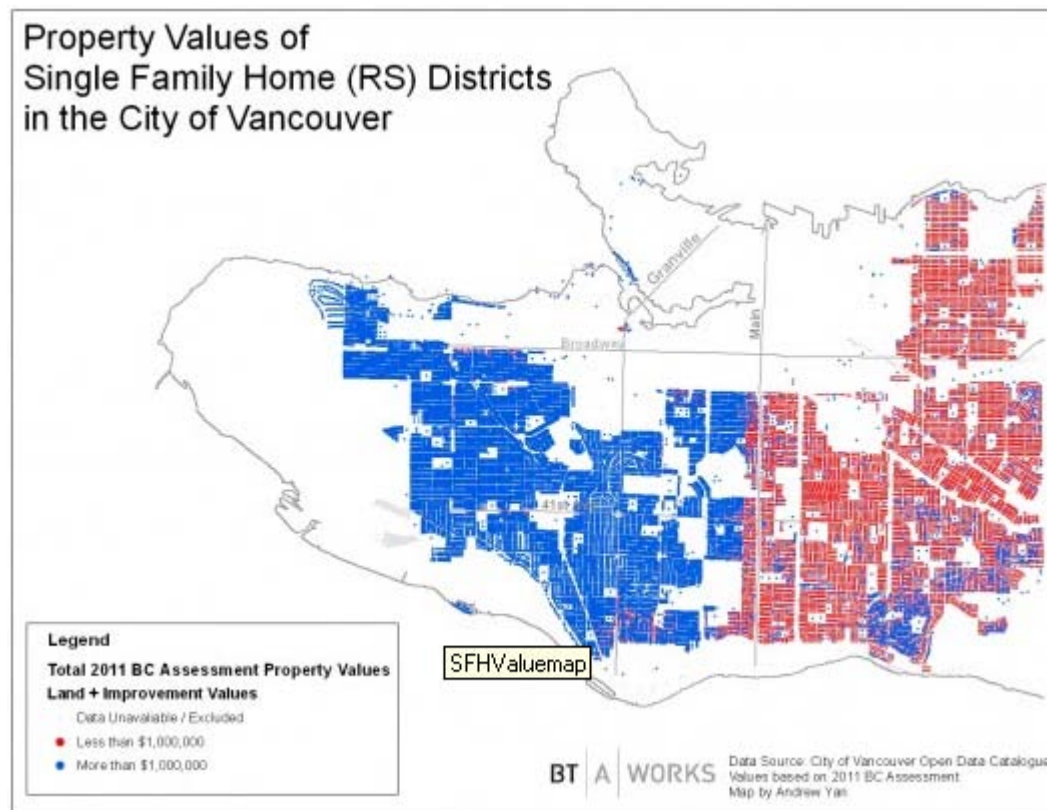

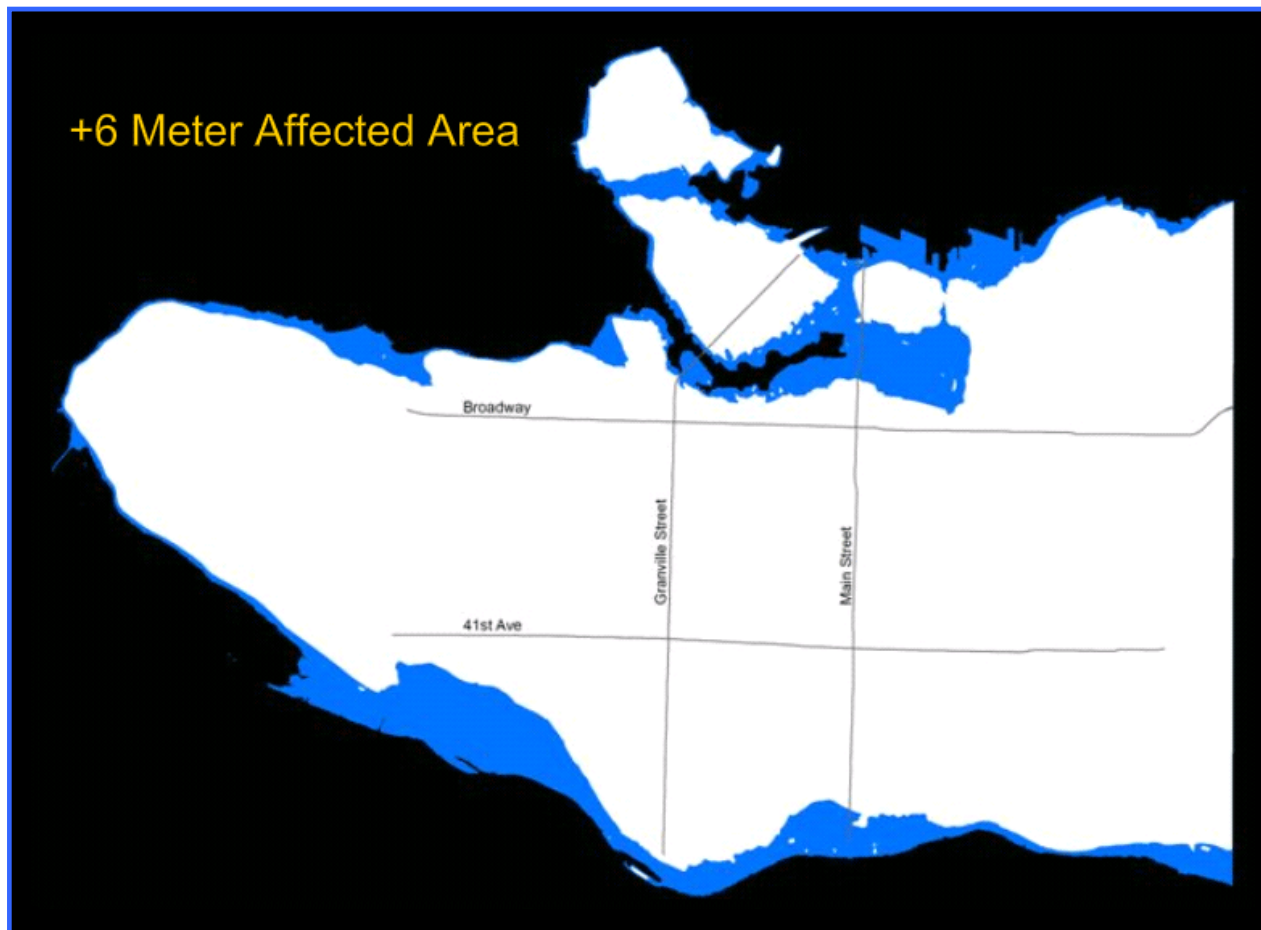
UBC Study Reveals “Bikeability” Index for Metro Vancouver



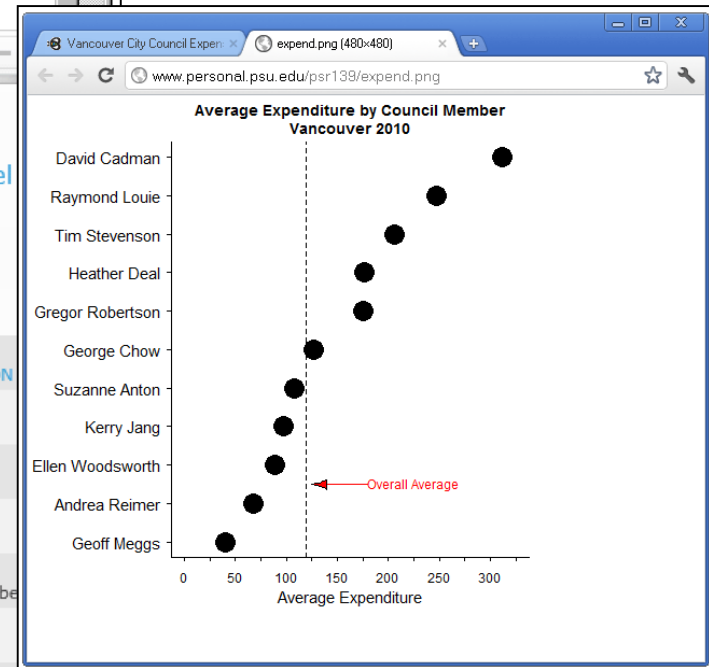
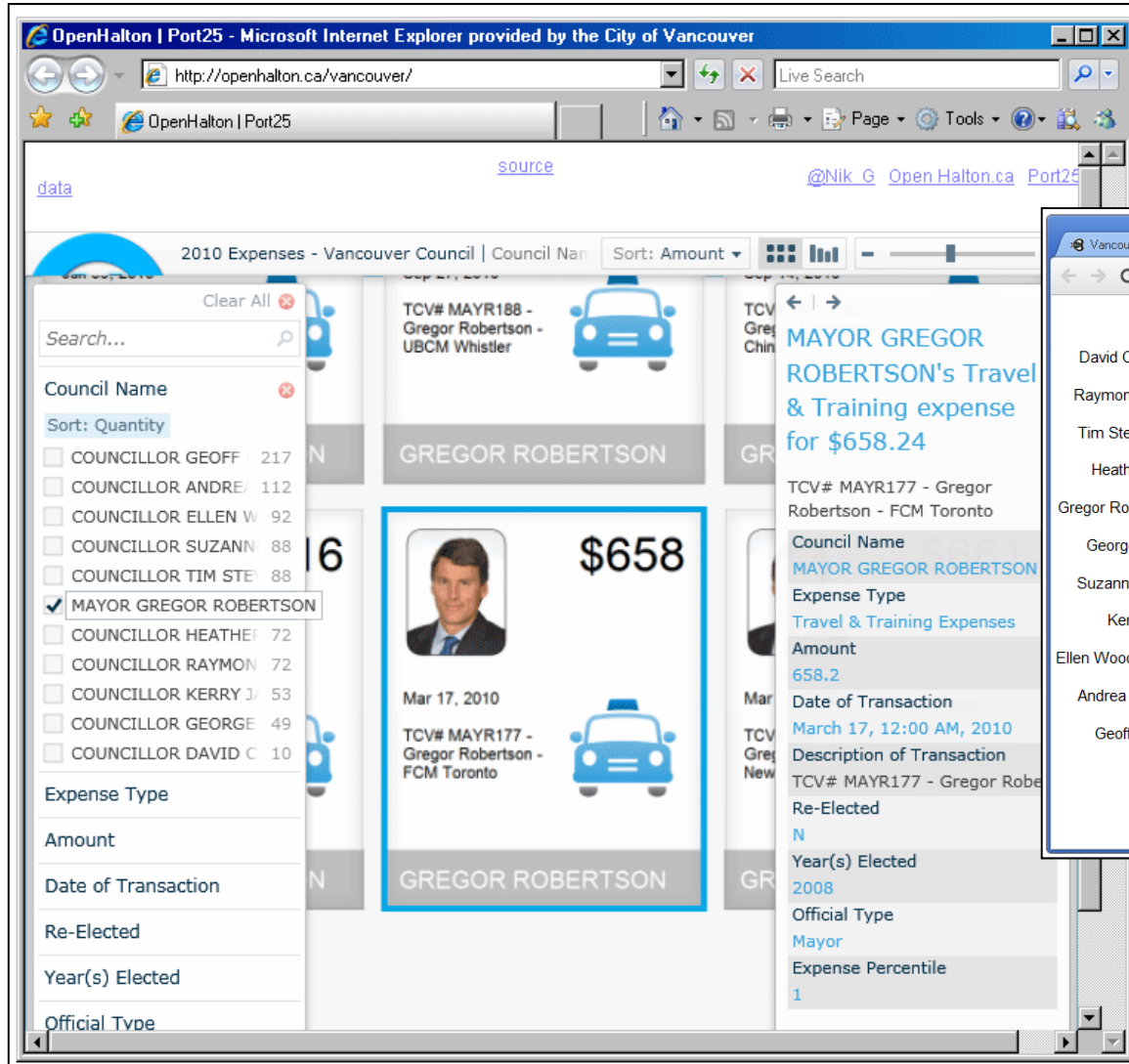
The East West Divide: Patterns in Housing Valuations and Political Preference

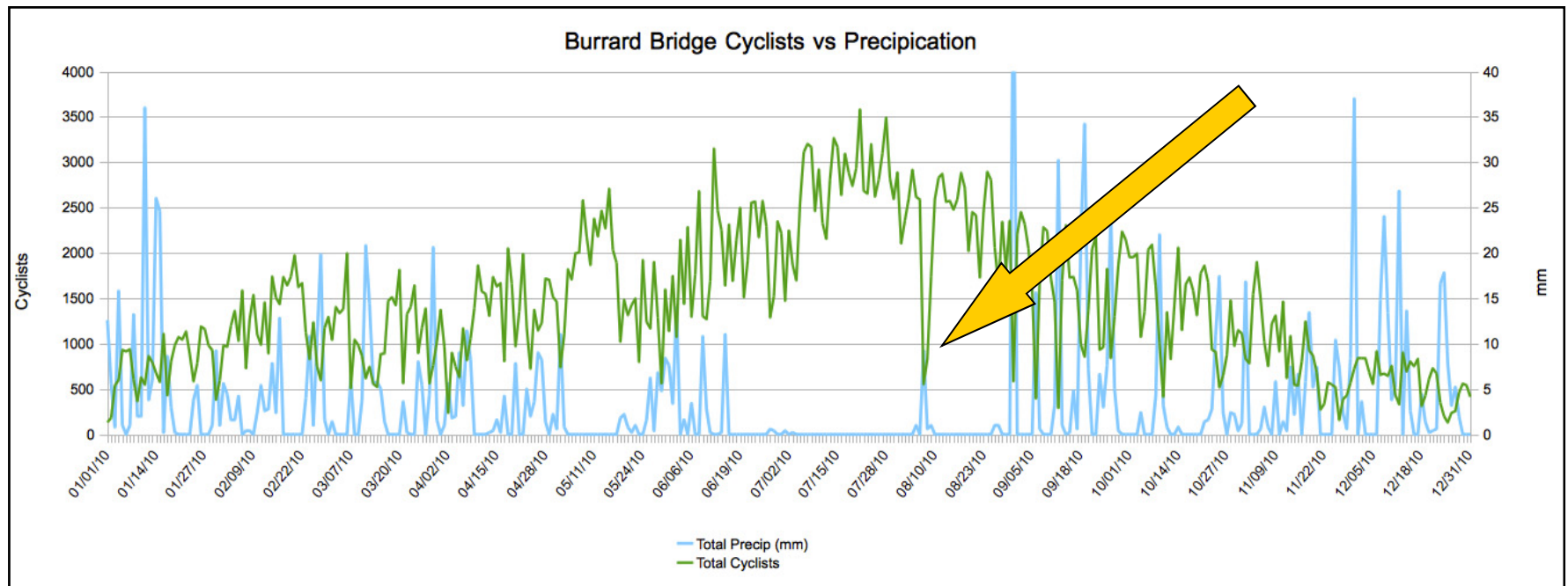

The other WESTBOUND routes taken from Union and Main have destinations along False Creek-Granville Is-Kits, Yaletown- English bay-Stanley Park, Chinatown, etc. This Mayor and Council has totally neglected connectors from Union & Main to these routes (Expo, Pacific and the interchange between Union & Main and the NORTH end of the Science World grounds)."

The fourth comment is from "Gary Woloski" (4 months ago): "Burrard Br users are coming from Kits and points beyond and unless they're on a recreational ride or going to East Van, they are pretty well stuck with Burrard Br." Below the comment are "Like" and "Reply" buttons.
