

VanMap: Bringing Geographic Data to Desktops



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What is VanMap?



- VanMap is an easy-to-use viewer of data that has a geographical reference
- Data is organized in layers that can be turned on and off individually or in groups

VanMap's Data Includes



- addresses and property lines
- zoning (and access to the bylaw)
- City and non-City utilities
- public places (schools, libraries, etc.)
- aerial photographs
- business and dog licenses
- ownership and assessed values
- many other layers

VanMap's Functionality



- Zooming in and out and panning
- Reports
- Notifications
- Measure distances
- Zoom to specific address and locations
- Copy and paste maps
- Print maps

VanMap's Business Drivers



- Desire to provide easy access to GIS and other spatial data
- Desire to support staff in their contact with the public because much of the contact is about property-related issues
- Desire to improve communication with the public

VanMap's Business Drivers



- Desire to improve service and facilitate self-service
- Desire to work with and support other City web initiatives such as Community Web Pages and Road Ahead
- Desire to promote enterprise approach to GIS

Key VanMap Benefits



- VanMap provides a visual map context for viewing data
- VanMap integrates data from a variety of City sources and applications
- VanMap provides access to more current data
- VanMap provides data sharing and encourages cleaner data
- VanMap provides the public with much of the same data that staff use to answer their questions

VanMap Directions



- Staff: continued incremental releases with additional data and functionality
- Staff: specialized versions of VanMap for specific work groups
- Public: incremental releases with additional data
- Continued integration with other City web initiatives
- Continuous improvement of usefulness and usability

What Makes VanMap Different



- VanMap is very rich in data
 - Staff version has over 90 layers of data
- VanMap is available to staff and the public
- Public version works with Internet Explorer, Netscape, and Macs
- VanMap is integrated with other City web initiatives
- VanMapLite is a “plug-in free” version

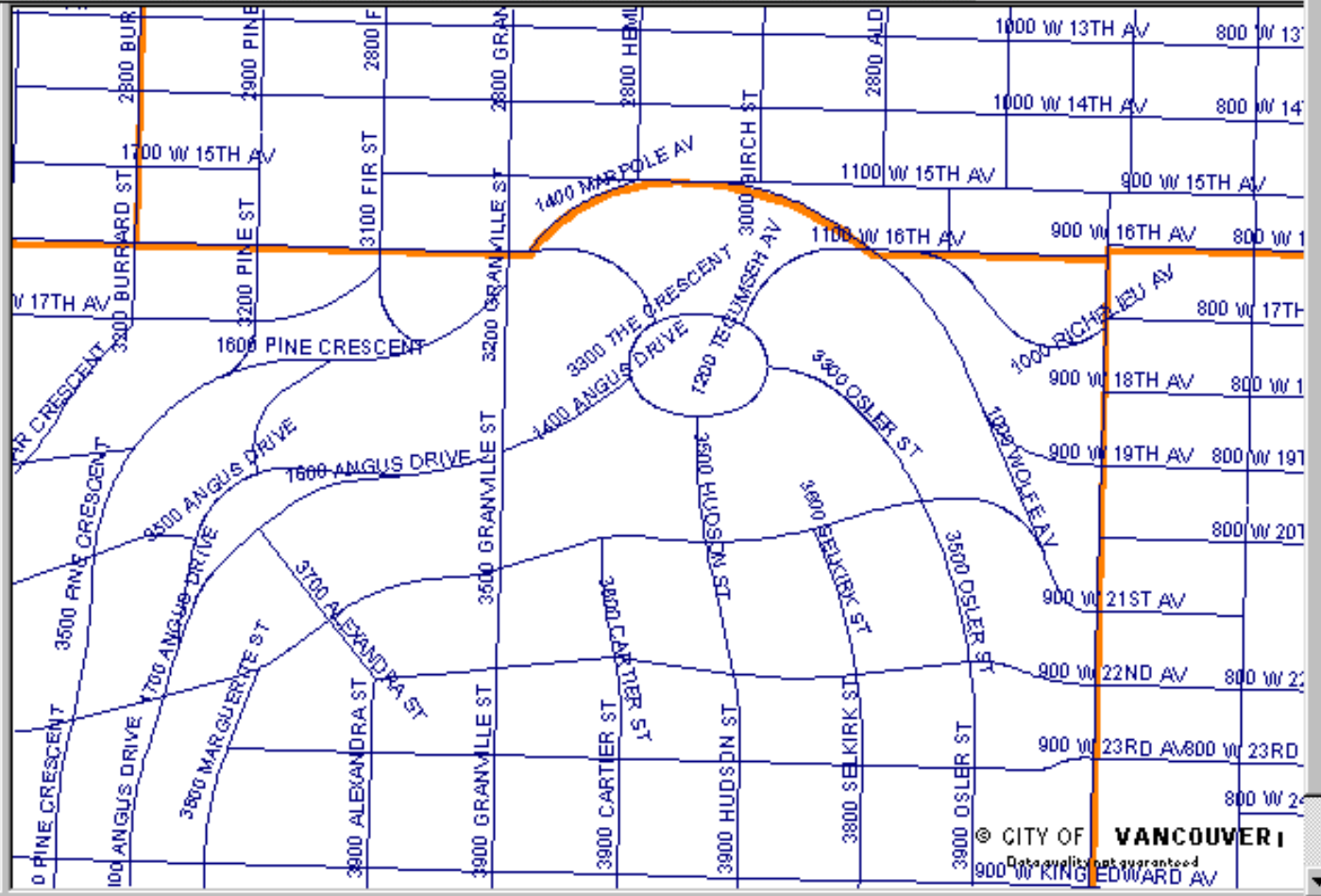

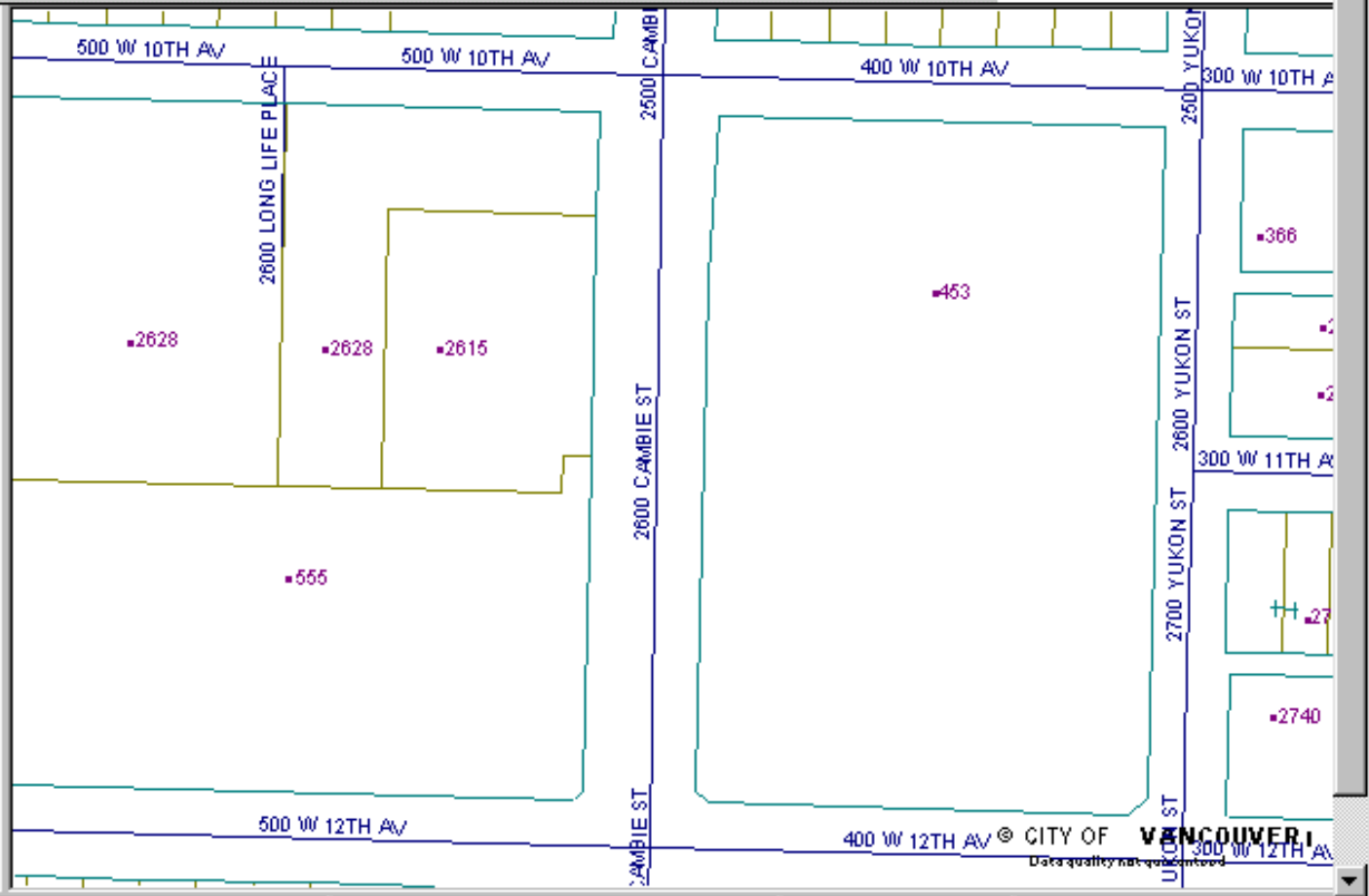

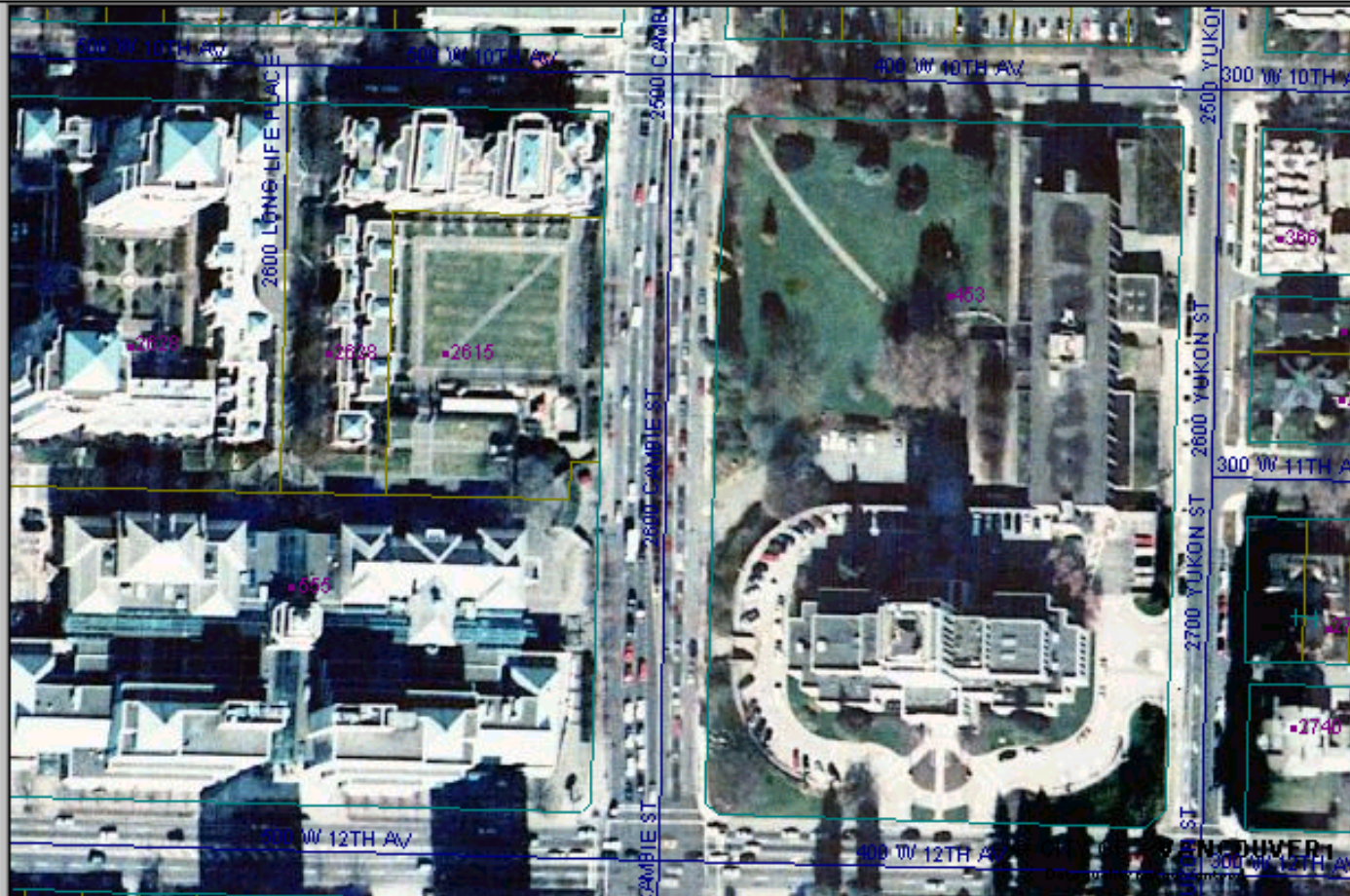
