





Dissemination Areas used as building blocks



Technical Aspects

- Spatial and Tabular Data
 - 1. Survey Data stored in MS Access database
 - 2. CAM Districts
 - Point locations identifying the Community Assets.
 The consultant utilized the legal lot centroids to spatial identify locations within Burnaby
 - For lots with multiple services, points were manually offset for display purposes
 - 4. Population Density raster layer
 - 5. 2001 DA Census Geography
 - 6. 20_20 Census .ivt files

- CAM District Creation
 - CAM Districts derived from aggregating the Census DA polygons (DA boundaries primarily follow roads and contain approximately 400-700 people).
 - Each CAM district has at least 30 kindergarten children





- CAMS web mapping layers
- 1. Masterfile layer in ArcSDE rendered to show:
 Child Care, City Operated, Community Services, Educational
 Institutions, Fed & Prov & FHA Services, Non-Market Housing &
 Care Facilities, Other Non-Profit Organizations, Religious Institutions,
 Services for People with Disabilities, Services for Seniors
- 2. Census Data rendered to show:

 Population, Age Distribution Count, Age Distribution %, Family,
 Education, Language, Economics
- 3. CAMS District
