Operating on a provincial land base of over 94 million hectares, the Ministry ensures the sustainable management of forest, wildlife, water and other land based resources; works with Indigenous and rural communities to strengthen and diversify their economies; and, supports activities that provide environmental, economic, cultural and social benefits.

BC Timber Sales manages about 20 per cent of the province's allowable annual cut for Crown timber, generating economic prosperity for British Columbians through the safe, sustainable development and auction of Crown timber.

BC Timber Sales also supports government's commitment to true, lasting reconciliation with First Nations in BC as we move toward fully adopting and implementing the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and the Calls to Action of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission.

The purpose of this position is to conduct advanced spatial data analysis in support of management decision making on resource planning, land management or other program issues. This is an exciting and diverse role where the Geospatial Analyst will work closely with other natural resource management professionals to advance sustainable forest and resource management in NW BC. This position has many opportunities to work on a variety of interesting projects. This type of work also supports career development opportunities to learn and grow.
