The Ministry of Forests is part of the BC Public Service and is responsible for natural resource management in BC. Our Ministry's Vision, Mission, and Reconciliation Commitment is as follows:

- **Vision:** resilient forests, landscapes, wildlife, and watersheds for the benefit of British Columbia, now and for generations to come.
- **Mission:** taking care of the land base through an integrated approach, in partnership with First Nations, communities and ministries.
- **Reconciliation Commitment:** implement the Declaration on Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act action plan, partner with First Nations in the stewardship of natural resources and advance the Ministry's culture towards reconciliation.

In this role, you will be working in a variety of settings, providing professional advice and may make decisions regarding the allocation of resources and adjudication of resource authorizations for the Natural Resource Sector.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Registered, or immediately eligible for registration, as a Professional Forester (RPF), with Forest Professionals BC (FPBC). Note: Immediately eligible for registration is defined as being able to transfer a current membership from an applicable jurisdiction to FPBC within six (6) months of employment. Confirmation of registration/eligibility is required before an offer of employment can be made.
- Degree in the natural resource field (i.e.: Geography, Environmental Studies, Resource Management, Agriculture, Forestry, Land Planning, Land Use Economics, etc.) or equivalent as recognized by the relevant association, **and** three (3) or more years of progressively responsible, recent experience in a natural resource management related field.
- Experience working in the field of resource management, preferably with forestry.
